GENERAL PROGRAMME

for the I. O. C. and Sports Federations meeting in Stockholm June 16th-22nd, 1947.

Monday, June 16th.

10 a. m. : *The representatives of the International Sports Federations meeting with the Executive Commission of the I. O. C. This meeting takes place in the building Södra Blasieholmshamnen 4 A, third floor. The building is situated near the Grand Hotel and the Royal Automobile Club.*

Tuesday, June 17th.

The meeting of the Federations continues.

Wednesday, June 18th.

10 a. m. : *Automobiles will fetch the participants outside the Royal Automobile Club and bring them to the site for the new sporting field of the city of Stockholm.*

3 p. m. : *Solemn opening ceremony of the International Olympic Committee at the House of Nobility.*

Thursday, June 19th.

10 a. m. : *Meeting of the I. O. C. at the building Södra Blasieholmshamnen 4 A, third floor.*

2,30 p. m. : *The I. O. C. received the delegations from the cities desirous of having the right to organize the Olympic Games 1952.*

Friday, June 20th.

The meeting of the I. O. C. continues.

Saturday, June 21st.

The meeting of the I. O. C. continues and is formally closed in the afternoon. This day the vote will be taken that decides which city shall organise the Olympic Games 1952.

Sunday, June 22nd.

Excursion to the sport University Bosön near Stockholm. From there the participants will take a boat trip through the archipelago and dine at the sea resort Saltsjöbaden.

SOCIAL EVENTS

The participants are invited to bring their ladies. Dinners will be given by the Swedish Sport Federations, by the City of Stockholm and by the President of the I. O. C.

The excursion to Bosön and the diner at Saltsjöbaden is given by the Swedish Olympic Committee.

As it is difficult to obtain hotel rooms in Stockholm, the participants are requested to order rooms at an early date on special cards obtained from the Swedish Olympic Committee, Strömsborg, Stockholm.

The best way to travel to Stockholm is by air. Direct aeroplanes go to Stockholm from Prague, Athen, Rome, Nizza, Geneva, Zürich, Lisbon, Paris, Amsterdam, London and other cities.
