

## *Housing of Competitors and Officials*

*Substantial progress has been made by the Organising Committee for housing the large number of competitors and officials coming to England for the Olympic Games from July 29th to August 14th, 1948.*

*Working in close co-operation with the Government, the Committee has definitely secured accommodation for over four thousand, and negotiations are well advanced towards providing for the remainder.*

*The Army Convalescent Camp in Richmond Park will house 1,500 competitors, while the R. A. F. Camps at Uxbridge and West Drayton will account for another 2,000. About 400 will be housed in the Torquay area for the yachting events and arrangements are in hand to cater for those taking part in the rowing and canoeing races which will be held at Henley-on-Thames.*

*Active negotiations are in progress to secure further suitable buildings in the Wembley area for the additional accommodation required.*
