On the occasion of a congress held in Rome in June last, it has been decided to create a PERMANENT INTERNATIONAL BUREAU FOR TIME RECORDING PERFECTIONMENT IN SPORTS AND GAMES

The city of Rome has been chosen for the seat of this organisation and the administrative council is constituted as follows :

1. The main object of this Bureau is to study the different means of time-recording in sports and games, to investigate or cause investigations to be made in technical improvements as well as in the practical working order with the view of reaching an ever increasing automatism and perfection of accuracy.

2. To group time-recorders of all nations and of all sports for the purpose of applying in each sport a single technique for the time-recording of each event.

3. To promote the standardisation of the modern time-recording apparatuses and material as used in all countries in view of obtaining every practical and economical advantage that such unification would afford.
