

Dates-giving Congress of the International Amateur Athletic Federation at Lausanne.

This Congress took place at Mon Repos in Lausanne on November 4th. 1950. Delegates of 11 nations participated in representing the following countries: Germany, Belgium, France, Great-Britain, Italy, Luxemburg, the Netherlands, the Saar, Sweden, Switzerland and Yugoslavia. At the end of each season the I. A. A. F. usually arranges a meeting of delegates of all the affiliated countries in order to establish a general program of all the representative contests and the chief international meetings. This Congress, presided over by Mr. Edouard Baudet, President of the Swiss Federation, has been officially opened by Mr. Marcel Henninger, President of the Swiss Olympic Committee. At the close of this Congress, the delegates visited the Olympic Museum of Lausanne. The next Congress will take place at Stockholm on November 3rd 1951.
