

## A PROPOSAL

*made by Mr. M. A. Bolanaki*  
has been adopted by the I. O. C.  
at its session in Vienna  
in May 1951.

The I. O. C. which is steeped in the basic principles of its charter as conceived by its founder Pierre de Coubertin, also inspired by the Olympic ideal, is always glad to rally around its flag the athlete of all the acknowledged Nations, with the sole object of creating a sportive brotherhood amongst all the peoples, without distinction of race, colour, religion or opinion.

Its only request being that the partakers and all the leaders will be responsible for a strict and honest application of the Rules and Statutes of the Charter, moved by the same Olympic spirit and for the good of humanity.
