Pursuant to an invitation received from the National Olympic Committee of U.S.S.R., President Avery Brundage visited Moscow and witnessed the great annual Parade of Sport held on July 18th. Several leaders of International Federations were present also. Afterward Pres. Brundage (who was making his third Olympic trip to Europe this year) travelled several thousand miles

in Soviet Union. He returned home by way of Helsinki, Stockholm, Copenhagen, Lausanne (the seat of the I.O.C.), London and other cities.
