

## **Presentation of the Fearnley and Mohammed Taher Cups to the Laureates of the year 1954**

In the course of a reception held at its seat on the 3rd of June 1954, the French Olympic Committee performed the presentation of the awards bestowed by the International Olympic Committee for the year 1954 :

The Fearnley Cup is awarded to the great University Club : Paris University Club.

The Taher Cup is awarded to the famous rugby player, former Captain of the team of France, and President Delegate of the French Rugby Association : Adolphe Jaureguy.

The French Olympic Committee celebrated on the same occasion the promotion of D<sup>r</sup> Mathieu, physician of the French Team at Hel-

sinki and of his Secretary Mr. P. Morel, who were promoted to the rank of Officers of the Legion d'honneur as well as the honour bestowed on the masseur of the Olympic French Team : Louis Themar who was made a Knight of this order.

Mr. Gaston Roux, General Managing Director of the youth and sport Movement deputised for the Minister of National Education.

A large number of personalities in the sporting world attended the reception.

A cocktail party followed the ceremony of the presentation of the awards. Later on, a dinner was given at the Pavillon Dauphine in honour of the Laureates.
