

Number of officials admitted in the Olympic Games

(this rule cancels the one which appeared in our edition Nr. 47.)

The Organizing Committee for the Games is not required to recognize more than the following number of officials, as certified by National Olympic Committees :

Teams of 15 or less competitors are allowed one official for each three competitors but not more than the number of competitors.

For the next 55 competitors (from 15 to 70), one additional official is allowed for each five competitors.

For the next 98 competitors (from 70 to 168), one additional official for each 7 competitors.

For the next 135 competitors (from 168 to 303), one additional official for each 9 competitors.

For teams of more than 300 competitors the officials must not exceed 15% of the number of competitors. Thus a team of 15 competitors is entitled to 5 officials ; a team of 70, 16 officials ; a team of 168, 30 officials ; a team of 303, 45 officials ; and a team of 400, 60 officials.
