About the Paris Session Minutes

On page 45 under "Olympic Academy at Athens", Mr. Jean Ketseas wishes to draw our attention that Mr. Georgaopoulo has only stipulated a wish about the functioning of that Organization which has been adopted, on *Mr. Ketseas'* proposal at the Rome Session in 1949.

As regards of the commission of 3 members mentioned under that same rubric, it has to be understood that it concerns the precedent item "protection of the ruins in Olympia" of which it has to study the problem and the one of the Academy.

Further, on page 37 of the minutes of the meeting of Paris with the National Olympic Committees, the remarks made about the Youth Festival were given by Mr. Piewcewicz,

member of said Committee, and not by Prof. Loth.

At that same meeting it was Mr. Reczek, Chairman of the Polan Olympic Committee who proposed that all future Agendas of the International Olympic Committee's Sessions should also be sent to the National Olympic Committees.

Dr. P. Chailley-Bert of Paris, who represented — with Dr. La Cava from Rome — the International Federation Medico-Sportive at the Olympic meetings of Paris in June 1955 remarks that said Federation does not figure on the List of Presence which appeared in our last edition. We apologize for that omission. We wish to mention that notice has been given of its presence on the original minutes.
