

## **The « Association Internationale de Boxe Amateur »**

**(International Amateur Boxing Association)  
introduces an Oath for Referees and Judges in the Olympic Games**

The A.I.B.A. has informed the Organizing Committee of the Melbourne Games, as well as the International Olympic Committee, that it has decided to require Referees and Judges for the Boxing competition to enter into an Oath, and it is adapting the one already in use in the International Gymnastics Federation, reading as follow:  
*I swear on my honour that in my capacity as Referee or Judge, I shall allow myself to*

*be guided only in the spirit of the loyalty and dignity of true sportsmanship and that I shall carry out my duties as the Olympic Games in accordance with the Rules, conscientiously, irrespective of persons or nations.*

It is proposed to administer the Oath immediately prior to the opening of the Boxing competition and it will be done by the President of the A.I.B.A.
