

## **The President's Olympic Travels in 1956**

President Brundage has been resuming his Olympic travels this year. After visiting Cortina d'Ampezzo (January and February) he went on to Lausanne and London. In May and June he undertook a second journey visiting Teheran where he presided over the "Olympic Week", he then went on to Beyrouth, Cairo, Lausanne and

Stockholm where he presided over the Conference of the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee, and attended the Equestrian Games of the XVIth Olympiad. He intends to visit shortly California in order to come into touch with the organizers of the Squaw Valley Winter Games.
