Mr. Willi Daume has been elected member of the International Olympic Committee at the recent Melbourne Session. He will function in the place of Duke Adolf-Friedrich of Mecklenburg who resigned and who was elected honorary member. Mr. Daume was

born on May 24th, 1913 and is a businessman in Dortmund. He is President of the German Federation of Sports, member of the Executive Board of the German Olympic Committee and Honorary President of the German Handball Federation. He was a member of the Handball and Basket-ball teams which represented Germany in the Olympic Games in Berlin in 1936. According to the new rules, Mr. Daume speaks also fluently French and English.
