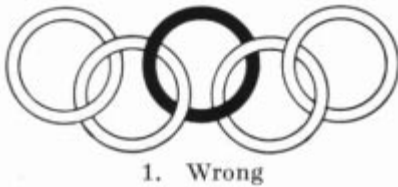


OFFICIAL INFORMATION

THE OLYMPIC RINGS

The Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee has decided to adopt a regulation where the *interlacing* of the Olympic rings is concerned. To do so it has taken as a model the first Olympic Flag which has been made in Paris in 1914 following Baron Pierre de Coubertin's instructions. As a comparison we publish hereby two pictures : Nr.1 is incorrect, while Nr.2 is the one which has been recognized.

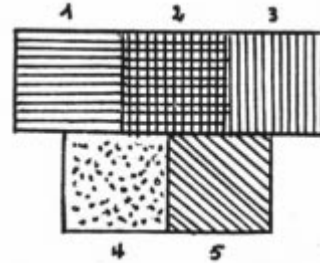
The Heraldic colours of the rings (for printing) are represented on our above picture. We reproduce them again enlarged and in detail as follow :



1. Wrong



2. Correct



1. Blue : Horizontal lines.
2. Black : Horizontal et Vertical lines (or black).
3. Red : Vertical lines.
4. Yellow : Stippled.
5. Green : Oblique lines (from left to right).
