

## The New Olympic Rules

The 1956 Edition of the *Rules* had no sooner been brought out than the International Olympic Committee came to realize that a complete revision was absolutely necessary in order to bring the rules up to date. In this respect, the Melbourne Games were an excellent test. The Executive Board completed its work in order to submit to the International Olympic Committee's Session in Sofia, the revised version of the new texts which have been approved and passed by the latter.

*The 1957 Edition has gone to Press* and the official organizing bodies will receive it presently. The persons who wish to obtain a copy of this new edition can do so by applying to the Chancellery of the International Olympic Committee in Lausanne, specifying if wanted in French or in English, along with remittance of 4 Swiss Frcs (or 1 dollar). This can be done either by cheques, or by International postal orders which can be obtained from any post-office.
