

CHANGES IN THE SQUAW VALLEY COMMITTEE

Robert L. King, chief assistant to Vice-President Richard M. Nixon, has been named executive director of the 1960 Winter Olympic Games Organizing Committee.

King replaces Alan E. Bartholemy, who has been retained by the committee as technical director of the Games. King will serve as administrative head of the committee,

where his long experience with top-echelon government affairs will be invaluable to the Olympic cause.

Bartholemy will continue in the important work of directing technical aspects of the contests and serving as chief liaison between the committee and winter sports organizations.
