
THE EXECUTIVE BOARD
of the International Olympic Committee
is to meet the National Olympic Committees of the Far East in Tokyo

Taking advantage of the fact that the 54th Session of the International Olympic Committee is to be held in Tokyo in May of this year, the Executive Board has taken steps to invite the Olympic Committees of the countries belonging to that part of the world to attend a non-official Meeting which is to be held in Tokyo on Friday May 16th 1958. As it is, the Asiatic Games are due to take place a few days after the end of the Session, when about twenty National Olympic Committees will be represented in the Japanese capital. It concerns the Committees of the following countries : Afghanistan, Burma, North-Borneo, Cambodia, Ceylon, China (Formosa), Hong-Kong, India, Indonesia, Iran, Israel, Japan, Korea, Malaya, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietman, The National Olympic Committee of China (Peking) which is not participating in these Games, has however been invited to attend this meeting, the principal aim of which is to develop the Olympic Movement

within these Committees, also to give their Delegates the opportunity of expressing their views and desires to the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee as they are seldom present when these Conferences are being held in Europe.
