

Statement published in the Melbourne ARGUS during the 1956 Games, on Nov. 27th
and **WHICH IS WORTH CONSIDERATION**

The glorious triumph of the Olympic Organization should fill national leaders with shame for THEIR inglorious failures. No statesman in control of any of the 68 nations harmoniously competing under the government of the International Olympic Committee has attempted to create comparable political organization of these nations.

Daily demonstrations at the Melbourne Cricket Ground afford a thundering and

moving assurance to national leaders of a mandate for essential action to rid their peoples of the hateful settlement of disputes by international dueling. If national statesmen will not get on with their job, they had better hand it over to the International Olympic Committee.
