The Organizing Committee is investigating the possibility of holding dogsled racing and curling exhibitions.

The Biathlon, a 20-km. event combining skiing and shooting (which was called up to 1948 'military patrols') will be held for the initial time in Olympic Games, but also for the last time as it has been excluded from the list of sports in the new Olympic Rules for the future Games.

Ladies' speed-skating competition will be held for the first time in the Games.

All events, excepting Cross-Country Skiing and the Biathlon, will be conducted in Squaw Valley proper. The Cross-Country events are scheduled at McKinney Creek, 12 miles south of Squaw Valley. However the Cross-Country competitors will be provided with practice courses in the Squaw Valley area.
