Sport and Philately (« Sport und Briefmarken »). German Edition D.M. 12.50. Edition Karl Ihl & Co., Coburg (Bavaria) Germany. Authors : Dr. Gerhard Schmidt, at Simmern and Günter Schneider, at Eisenberg.

The above is a first-rate edition consisting of 300 pages with about 1200 illustrations of Olympic and sports stamps quoting their value and their source of origin from over one hundred countries. Almost every stamp is outlined by a brief historical notice. This work is probably the best book published to date on this subject and can be highly recommended as being of particular interest to philatelists and amateur collectors of sporting and Olympic stamps. We congratulate the authors for having conceived and realized such an achievement.
