The New Zealand Olympic Association has suffered a great loss in the death of its President, the late Mr. A. D. Bayfeild.

'Bay' as he was affectionately known to so many, was the *grand old man* of the Olympic Movement in New Zealand. His first love was rowing and he represented the New Zealand Rowing Association on the Olympic body for many years. He was a foundation delegate at the inaugural meeting of the New Zealand Olympic Association in 1911, and served continuously until his death, as chairman 1942-1948, and as president 1948-1960.

He was a man of sterling character, whose contribution both as a prominent oarsman and rugby player in his day and subsequently as an able administrator, will long be remembered. The Association is the richer for his years of service.
