*To the International Olympic Committee,
Lausanne*

July 27, 1959.

‘In our Committee’s bulletin number 71, two small articles appear, one signed by Jose de J. Clark as President of the Central America and Caribbean Sports Organization, and the other one by Ing. Marte R. Gomez as President of the Mexican Olympic Committee. I wish to inform you the following:

‘Since June 1959, Ing. Gomez is not President of the Mexican Olympic Committee, as per notice sent to you, although we are pleased to advise you that he is our Honorary President.

‘The Central America and Caribbean Sports Organization selected as President Mr. Julio Enrique Monagas, entitled also to the Puerto Rico Olympic Committee, and they conferred to me the post of Honorary President.

‘Finally, the Mexican Olympic Committee returned to its former location at *Plaza de Buenavista* 2-411.

‘I beg you to take note of the above and would appreciate very much if said changes would appear in the next bulletin.
