

The Mediterranean Games

A congress of the Mediterranean Games was held on August 27th 1960 under the presidency of Cheikh Gabriel Gemayel with the view to settle the choice of the city which is to stage the 4th Games. Since no resolution was reached, it was decided to convene a new Congress which is to be held at Athens in 1961 for the purpose of choosing the host city. After almost two hours of discussing, the Statutes were adopted subject to a few modifications to the project proposed by Cheikh Gemayel. The Committee of these Games was appointed as follows:
