



A Seal of the International Olympic Committee

We reproduce here the oldest seal (vignette) where Olympism is concerned. It was created by Baron de Coubertin in 1894, year of the foundation of the International Olympic Committee. There is a limited stock remaining at the chancellery of the International Olympic Committee in Lausanne where it can be obtained against payment of the amount of 2 dollars (or the equivalent in foreign currency). The colour of that seal is white printing on blue ground.
