This book is published in collaboration with the Amateur Swimming Association of Great-Britain. It is a revised edition of the first release in 1950. It describes and

illustrates how to swim correctly the front crawl, back crawl and breast stroke; how to master the respective turns and how to dive. An introductory section for beginners shows them how to start off confidently, and for more advanced swimmers there is a closing section on competition laws.
