INVITATION

The Hellenic Olympic Committee has the pleasure to inform you that the Second Course of the International Olympic Academy will be held at Olympia, as from the 9th to the 21st of July 1962.

In accordance with Art. 4 of the approved Regulations of the International Olympic Academy, the special subjects, which will be embraced in the courses of 1962, shall be as follows:

1. Origin and history of the Olympic Movement.
2. The Work of Baron Pierre de Coubertin.
3. The contribution of the Olympic Ideals for the conduct of good citizenship.
4. Fine Arts and competitive sports, in ancient and contemporary times.
5. The influence of science on the improvement in the methods of training.

Distinguished scientists, who are experts on these subjects, have been invited to deliver the relative lectures.

The Hellenic Olympic Committee thereby invites the designated representatives of your Country, in accordance with Art. 3 para. 1 of the Provisory Regulations of the International Olympic Academy.
