

# The 60th Session of the International Olympic Committee transferred

That Session which had to place in Nairobi (Kenya) has been transferred on August 20th by a decision taken by the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee to *Baden-Baden* (Germany). That resolution has been taken due to the fact that the Kenya Government (following the decisions taken by the African countries in Addis-Abeba) has refused the entry in Kenya to the Olympic delegations of South Africa and Portugal. The International Olympic Committee will, we trust, never permit

anyone to decide who will or will not attend its meetings.

That decision is of no concern with the participation of Kenya in the 1964 Olympic Games (as certain press mentioned it) as the Olympic Committee of that country is not responsible of a political discrimination decided by its Government.

The Session of Baden-Baden, as well as the meeting of the National Olympic Committees with the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee took place from October 14th to 20th 1963.
