THROWING. — Edited by 'Educational Productions Ltd.', East Ardsley, Wakefield, Yorkshire, England.

A new publication from the Series 'Sport-Athletics'. 32 pages and over 60 illustrations. Price 2/6 d.

This is the third and final book in the popular series dealing with athletic events, the first two of which dealt with running and jumping. This latest publication deals with the shot, discus, javelin and hammer. Each event is thoroughly examined. Practices for beginners are included; technique is dealt with in detail; and invaluable training hints are given. Concluding the book is a general section on conditioning and weight training activities.

The book is fully illustrated to bring out, even more forcefully, the points made in the text. It has been written for athletics of both sexes, young and not so young. Teachers and coaches will also find it a helpful guide.
