

# List of amendments to the Olympic Rules *since Edition 1962*

**Page 10**, bottom, add at the end of asterisk paragraph :

*Recognition of an Olympic Committee in such an area*

1. *does not imply political recognition, as this is outside the competence of the International Olympic Committee ;*
2. *is dependent on the area having had a stable Government for a reasonable period.*

**Page 16, Rule 24**, third line : add after 'country' :

*or geographical area*

**Page 19, Rule 27**, second sentence must be replaced by :

*It is not permissible for a competitor having once worn the colours of a country in the Olympic Games or World or Area Games or Championships to wear those of another country in a future Games. The exception to this rule is when his former country has been incorporated in another State, or if he wore the colours of the former country because his native land had, at that time, no National Olympic Committee, or after he has become naturalized and a period of at least three years has passed since he applied for naturalization, or in the case of a woman, when she has taken new nationality by marriage.*

**Page 20, Rule 30** add after 'fifteen'

*and a maximum of eighteen*

The last sentence of this page must be replaced by :

*The program of sports will be fixed by the International Olympic Committee at the time the invitations to stage the Games are to be considered and no change is permitted thereafter.*

**Page 21, Rule 33**, second line :

*Ski, Skating, Ice-Hockey, Bobsleigh, Luge and Biathlon.*

**Page 24, third line :**

*cancel d) the whole line.*

Line 4, after 'under 1' cancel *and d.*

*e) becomes d)*

*f) » e)*  
*and so forth.*

**Page 25, Rule 38, end of the rule :**

*Juges, members of the Jurys, referees, do not belong in the delegation of a National Olympic Committee.*

**Page 29, Rule 48, bottom :**

*Twelve seats shall be reserved for the International Federations in the stadia where their own competitions are staged.*

**Page 32, Rule 51, line 4.**

Replace five by *six*.

**Page 32, Rule 52, third paragraph :**

After 'Opening Day' *cancel the rest of the sentence.*

**Page 33, Rule 55, at the end of the first paragraph, add :**

*Invitations shall be sent by mail and not by diplomatic channels.*

**Page 34, line 7 : end of the Rule 56.**

Replace 'together with' by *as well as*

**Page 38, third paragraph, line 5 :**

Punctuer at the end of the line.

**Line 6.** *One city only per country is entitled to be candidate* replaces 'and only one invitation from a country will be considered'.

**Line 11,** cancel 'Invitations must have the approval of the Government of and replace by

*Any candidature must be supported by the Government of*

**Page 39, Paragraph 4.**

add after 'fifteen' *and not more than 18.*

**Eligibility Rules of the International Olympic Committee.**

Under 'Official Interpretations' a new section :

*The International Olympic Committee reserves to itself the right to make exceptions to these rules in the case of sports or individuals, provided that the basic principles that an athlete does not make a profit or livelihood out of his sport is not infringed.*
