## General programme

**8th August** All participants should arrive in Athens by the evening and report to the Hellenic Olympic Committee's Hostel (attached to the Panathinaïkon Stadium), Archimideus Str. 12. Tel. No. 723.428.

**9th August** Conducted sightseeing

**10th August** Inauguration of the Fourth Session and first talk.  
 Reception given by the Hellenic Olympic Committee.

**11th August** Early departure for Olympia by motor coaches with visits en route to historic sites, including the Stadia of Isthmia and Epidaurus. In the evening of the same day the participants will be installed at the camp of the International Olympic Academy at Olympia.

**12th-21st August** Session at Olympia.

**21st August** The members of the International Olympic Academy will participate at the Ceremony of 'the Lighting of the Olympic Flame for the Tokyo Olympic Games.

**22nd August** Return to Athens.  
 In the evening, attendance at the Olympic Flame Ceremony in the Panathenæan Stadium.

**23rd August** Departure of the participants.  
 For those who wish, an excursion to Delphi will be

organized with return to Athens the same evening.

The Programme will include optional activities, sports, excursions, sea bathing etc.

The official languages are English and French. There will also be discussions, debates and seminars in which the participants will be encouraged to take part. Debates and seminars will include subjects arising out of the talks and special subjects.

## Lodging

Before leaving for Olympia and after the return to Athens, the participants will be lodged at the hostel of the 'Panathinaïkon Stadium' - 12 Archimideus Str. Pangrati - Athens, Tel. No. 723.428.

The Hellenic Olympic Committee will arrange for accommodation from the 8th until noon of the 23rd August.

In Olympia the participants will be quartered in a camp. The tents will be equipped with all necessary lodging items (beds, sheets, blankets, etc.). Items of personal use (clothing, bathing suits, sport outfits, musical instruments, etc.) should be provided by the participants themselves.

## Fees

The fees (including lodging, meals, transportation to and from Olympia, excursion fares) have been fixed at US \$ 3.— per day. Those arriving on other than the fixed dates will be charged extra with their fares (Athens-Olympia).

The fees should be paid to the Hellenic Olympic Committee, on arrival.
