

The 5th session of the International Olympic Academy

8th - 24th August 1965

The Hellenic Olympic Committee has pleasure in informing you that the International Olympic Academy under the patronage of the International Olympic Committee and sponsored by the Hellenic Olympic Committee, will hold its 5th session at Olympia from the 8th to the 24th August 1965.

The Hellenic Olympic Committee invites all National Olympic Committees to send their nominees for participation.

Hereunder are the details of the 5th session :

Lectures :

The subjects include both the ancient and modern Olympic Games, the Olympic Ideology, modern education for athletics and sports, the aims of Baron Pierre de Coubertin, technical subjects and in particular for this session, medical aspects and dietetics in Sports, as also Art and Civilisation and Sports.

Besides the regular lecturers, the Academy has invited world renowned experts to deliver relevant talks.

The official languages are French and English. There will be translations in both languages available for all talks.

There will also be discussions, debates and seminars arising out of the talks and special subjects in which the participants will be encouraged to take part.

The programme will include optional activities, sports, excursions, sea bathing etc.

General programme :

8th August

Participants' arrival in Athens.

9th August

Conducted sightseeing. Inauguration of the 5th session. Reception by the Hellenic Olympic Committee.

10th August

Departure for Olympia with visits en route to historical sites, including the stadiums of Isthmia and Epidaurus. In the evening the participants will be installed at the camp of the International

Olympic Academy at Olympia.

11 -22nd August

Works of the 5th session at Olympia.

Return to Athens in the evening of the 22nd.

23rd August

Optional excursion to Delphi.

24th August

Departure of participants.

Lodging :

The Hellenic Olympic Committee will arrange for accommodation of the participants from the 8th until noon of the 24th of August.

In Olympia the participants will be quartered in a camp. The tents will be equipped with all necessary lodging items (beds, sheets, blankets etc.). Items of personal use (clothing, bathing suits, sport outfits, musical instruments etc.) should be provided by the participants themselves.

Fees :

Including lodging, meals, transportation to and from Olympia, excursion fares, have been fixed at US \$ 3.— per day. Those arriving on other than the fixed dates will be charged extra with their fare to Olympia.

The fees should be paid to the Hellenic Olympic Committee on arrival.
