

We also include here the text of the telegram dated February 6th sent by Mr. Richard J. Daley, Mayor of Chicago, to Mr. Avery Brundage, President of the I.O.C.

" The words of high moral value which you addressed to participants of the Olympic Winter Games with, were listened to by the entire population of Chicago, who thank you for the example you set to the youth of the United States, thus proving your generous gift in favour of the maintenance of international friendship, through development of amateur sport."
