

THE COMMISSIONS FOR PRESS AND
PUBLIC RELATIONS

Gathered on January 31st at 2 p.m. in the Town Hall of Grenoble under the chairmanship of Lord Killanin, the Full Commission for Press and Public Relations took the following decisions, which were afterwards ratified by the 66th Session of the I.O.C.

IOC Publications :-

- Monthly news letter
- Annual review
- Who's who
- List of members, National Olympic Committees and International Federations
- Booklet on the Olympic Ideal
- Book of Regulations.

The submitted projects were accepted. Most of those works will be published before Mexico.

Film :-

A film for a large audience exalting the Olympic ideal is contemplated for the Olympic Games.

Accreditation of the Press :-

A proposition from the "Associated Press" Agency that the accreditation of the press be based upon precise regulations was discussed at length ; its wording? elaborated by the A.I.P.S. will be examined so that directives without any ambiguity can be despatched to Organising Committees.

Official Card :-

It is also contemplated to provide the journalists who usually deal with the problems of the I.O.C. with an official card.

I.O.C. Sessions :-

Whenever I.O.C. sessions occur, two Press conferences are to be given daily, one at 12.00 and one at 17.00 hrs.

The newly set-up Commission of Enquiry into Olympic Winter Games is under the chairmanship of the Jonkheer Herman von Karnebeek (Netherlands). It is composed of H.R.H. the Grandduke Jean of Luxemburg, of Mr. Erik von Frenckell (Finland), Mr. Alexandru Siperco (Rumania) and Mr. Jan Staubo (Norway).
