

SPORTS BUILDINGS AFTER THE OLYMPIC GAMES

If - after having served towards the success of the Winter Games at Grenoble, and having confirmed once again the magnitude of the Olympic idea - the buildings were used no more, they would have partially achieved their goal. The ice-rink at Grenoble was conceived in such a manner that after the Games it could be transformed into a regular Sports Palace, though the formulation of the architects plans for several possibilities of reconversion were a constant trouble.

Some of the plans will allow for basket-ball, volleyball, gymnastics, horse-shows and indoor athletics to be practised.

The installations of a bicycle-track is now being examined, the enlargement of the track is perfectly possible as the tiers which surround the evolution ground are portable. This being so the ice-rink that saw the prowess of the athletes during the Winter Games will serve again.
