

MR. AVERY BRUNDAGE IN LAUSANNE

The President of the International Olympic Committee, Mr. Avery BRUNDAGE, arrived in Lausanne on the 17th January. On the 19th he was joined by Mr. Hugh WEIR, member of the International Olympic Committee for Australia, who will assist him throughout his stay and will take charge of the administration of the Lausanne headquarters as a result of the resignation of the Secretary General, which was announced on the 20th January in the following words:

The resignation of Secretary General WESTERHOFF, as reported in the Mexico City Minutes, is accepted with regret as of this date.

Mr. WESTERHOFF finds that because of his other responsibilities he is unable to devote the time required, owing to the increased activities of the International Olympic Committee.

He has kindly consented to continue in an advisory capacity for the next few months.

The International Olympic Committee is seeking a man to take over the management of the Lausanne office at the Château de Vidy.
