



OLYMPIC COINS IN GERMANY

A 10-Mark silver piece will be coined again in Germany this year, for the first time in half a century.

The model was selected on the results of a competition. The obverse shows the Federal eagle, while the reverse features the emblem of the 1972 Summer Games. Three other coins will be minted, one each year up to 1972.

The Bavarian Mint will transfer seven of the ten marks represented by these coins to the Olympic fund. In this way, a contribution of some 70 million marks is expected to be raised towards the financing of the Games.
