

WITHIN THE NATIONAL OLYMPIC COMMITTEES

The West Indies Olympic Association, whose first and the only president was Mr. Herbert G. MACDONALD, has been dissolved.

ECUADOR

- Mr. Voltaire PALADINES P., President of the Ecuadorian Olympic Committee succeeded Dr. Agustin ARROYO YEROVI who recently became a member of the International Olympic Committee. The General Assembly of the Ecuadorian Olympic Committee held on the 15th December 1968 also appointed the members of its Executive Board for the 1968-1972 period as follows : Dr. Patricia ROMERO B., first vice-president, Mr. Alberto VALLARINO, treasurer, Mr. Carlos BAQUERIZO S., second vice-president and Mr. Eduardo RODRIGUEZ G., secretary general.

PORTUGAL

- Next month (February) new internal regulations will be adopted by the Portuguese Olympic Committee. The Executive Board, consisting of nine active and three deputy members will be elected for a four year period.

UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

- Mr. A. D. TOUNY, member of the International Olympic Committee for the United Arab Republic was recently elected a member of Parliament, as representative of his native town, Mallawi.

RUMANIA

- Several sports installations will be opened during the next months in Rumania. For instance a stadium holding 2000 spectators will be opened at Timisoara, others at Pitesli, Cällãras. Constantza and in the town of Gheorghe Gheorghui-Dy. 1969 will see the completion of the work on the building of indoor swimming pools in the sports complex "August 23rd" in Bucarest. The erection of a new stadium for 12,000 spectators will be started this year in Bucarest.
