A rather belated issue at the beginning of the year of a brown, black, red and blue airmail stamp commemorating the Mexico Olympic Games. Value: 65 F. C.F.A.  
Subject: a swimmer.

Issue last February of a set of eight stamps featuring Olympic Champions of the past: Paavo NURMI (Finland) - 5m. -, Jesse OWENS (USA) - 10m. -, Francina BLANKERS-KOEN (Holland) - 15m. -, Laszlo PAPP (Hungary) - 20m. -, Wilma RUDOLPH (USA) - 30m. -, Boris SAHLIN (USSR) - 60m. -, Don SCHOLLANDER (USA) - 80m. -, Akinori NAKAYAMA (Japan) - 1T. -.

### POLAND

A set of eight issued in 1969. Under the Olympic rings can be seen an athlete (10 g.), a gymnast (20g.), a weight-lifter (40g.), a javelin thrower (60g.), a discus thrower (2.502 + 50g.), a hurdler (3.402 + 12g.), two wrestlers (42 + 1.502), a fencing match (72 + 229.).

Three subjects (canoeing - 30p., blue; running - 50p., yellow; football - 100p., green) devoted to the Mexico Olympics. 500,000 sets were printed. First day of issue: February 3rd, 1969.
