

THE I.O.C. COMMISSIONS

The Cultural Commission, presided over by Mr. Włodzimierz RECZEK, IOC member for Poland and President of the Polish Olympic Committee, held its first meeting in Rome on the 14th and 15th April, 1969.

The Eligibility Commission assembled at the end of April in Bucharest to work out the points to be presented during the Warsaw Session.

The Co-ordinating and Supervising Committee for IOC/NOC Relations will meet in Lausanne on the 30th May.

Its President, General José de J. CLARK, Vice-President of the IOC, wants, before Warsaw, to establish the first working schedule for the five joint IOC/NOC Commissions, which since the Mexico Session are responsible for reviewing all questions concerning the National Olympic Committees.

The Commission for Legislation, Discrimination and Relations between NOCs and their Governments, presided over by Mr. Erik von FRENCKELL, Member of the IOC for Finland.

5th June

The Press and Public Relations Commission, under the presidency of The Lord Killanin, Vice-President of the IOC and President of the Irish Olympic Committee.

The Joint IOC/NOC Aid Commission, under the presidency of Mr. Juan Antonio SAMARANCH, IOC Member for Spain and President of the Spanish Olympic Committee.

The Joint IOC/NOC Commission for the Olympic Programme, Officials at the Games and Designation of Cities to stage the Games, under the presidency of Mr. Arpad CSANADI, IOC Member for Hungary.
