THE CENTRAL AMERICAN GAMES

* The 11th Central American Games, founded in 1926, were held in Panama from February 28th to April 14th.

Fifteen events, with 2.000 participatns from 19 countries. Cuba sent the biggest delegation (277 men and 95 women).

The main stadium (20.000 spectators) was provided with a tartan track, the second in Latin America.

THE PAN AMERICAN GAMES

* The 6th Pan American Games are to be held from July 25th to August 8th, 1971 at Cali (Colombia), a town of about one million inhabitants, situated in the valley of the Cauca, in the western Cordilleras, some 100 miles to the East of the Pacific Ocean.

Cali prides itself on being the capital of Colombian sport and as such possesses many facilities that have served in countless international competitions and championships.

The Pan American Village, capable of accommodating 4.000 athletes, will be completed one month before the start of the Games.
