Dr. Schöbel, member of the I.O.C. for the German Democratic Republic, is best of all known for the quality of the works that he publishes as much in the text, as by the image and the care taken over everything.

It was Dr. Schöbel who edited, in English and German versions. "THE FOUR DIMENSIONS OF AVERY BRUNDAGE".

Today Olympia and its Games comes out in Russian, it has already appeared in French, English and German. This book which, in a simple form, explains the organization of the Games in ancient times, retraces the life of the athletes and is as the author so rightly underlines in his preface "*a stimulant for those who are interested in Olympie*".

It contains the results of all the heats, qualifying events, and finals as well as the biographies of the great Olympic champions of the whole world. The author has succeeded in interspersing his accounts of the competitions with a number of thrilling anecdotes. This book is unique of its kind in world sports literature.
