ANDORRA

* A commemorative stamp, to the value of 0.80 F. (printed in azure, sepia and dark blue) was issued, on 21st February 1970, on the occasion of the 7th World Handball Championships.

BULGARIA

* For the World Football Championships 1970, the Bulgarian Postal Services issued, on 2nd February 1970 a series of stamps in six values (1, 2, 3, 5, 13 and 20 st) representing players, as well as two blocks: 80 and 20 st., designed by V. VASSILEVA and A. DENKHO.

CONGO REPUBLIC

* From the extraordinary issue "*Brotherhood and Human Solidarity*", we have taken these stamps which have a sports theme:

- 2 F Javelin (blue, yellow, orange, brown and pale maroon).
- 5 F Javelin (blue, yellow, orange, brownish black, green and maroon).
- 15 F High Jump (blue, yellow, orange, black and flesh).
- 50 F Running (blue, orange, green, greyish-black, blackish-purple and flesh).
- 100 F Torch Bearer (blue, yellow, red, light blue, dark blue, ochre, blue-black, maroon and flesh).

MALAWI

* To be issued on 3rd June 1970 in 4 values (4 d, 9 d, 1/6 and 3), on the occasion of the 9th Commonwealth Games. Design by J.E. COOTER, representing a runner.

YEMENI REPUBLIC

* To commemorate the World Football Championships - Jules RIMET Cup - 1970, the issue of a series of new stamps, printed together on one sheet with a vignette mentioning the names of the 16 states taking part in the Championships, and in 2 blocks.

On each stamp of this series there is:

- the name of the country where one of the preceding Championships were held
- a reproduction of a monument in that country
- the name of the two finalists and the final result
- the geographic outline of the winning country

On the 2 blocks there is:

- the Brazilian Champ on PELE
- the German Champion BECIENBAUER
