* Mr. Donald F. MAGARRELL, senior Vice President of the National Bank of Colorado, who has been Acting Secretary General of the Denver Organizing Committee (DOC) since the first of September, 1970, has been named officially to this position.

In announcing this appointment, Mr. Robert J. PRINGLE, President of the DOC stated:

"This appointment is the first step in our preparations to implement the future recommendations of the study being conducted by the Denver Research Institute. Mr. MAGARRELL brings to this position a great deal of knowledge of the Olympics as well as his executive talent."

* The Denver Organizing Committee has recently announced that Sno-engineering, Inc., of Evergreen, Colorado, and Franconia, New Hampshire, has been retained to coordinate a complete review of the sites for the 1976 Olympic Winter Games.

Mr. Ted FARWELL of Evergreen, Vice President of the firm and a former Olympic competitor, will direct the re-evaluation of the Olympic sites.

In making this appointment, Mr. Robert J. PRINGLE, President of the Denver Organizing Committee, said that Sno-engineering will be charged in the re-evaluation with recognition of two key objectives of the Committee:

1. To stage the Olympic Games with the maximum use of existing facilities, and
2. Where facilities have significant after-use potential, to develop them in order to provide lasting benefits to the community, and where after-use is not justified, to assure restoration of all affected areas.
