- * Olympic Winter Games - Sapporo. Issue: October-November, 1970. Four values (surface mail): 2 - 3 - 4 and 10 dh. Two values (air mail): 2 and 5 R. One block of 15 R.

PARAGUAY

- * Munich 1972. Issue: 28th September, 1970. Seven values (surface mail): 0.10 - 0.15 - 0.20 - 0.25 - 0.30 - 0.50 and 0.75 G. Printing: 250,000 series. Two values (air mail): 12.45 and 18.15 G. Three blocks of 23.40 G: one denticulated, two not denticulated.

- * The C.O.N.I. has placed on show a notable selection of its collection of stamps in the form of a philatelic exhibition last October at the Palais des Congrès in Rome on the occasion of "Rome 1970". Among the stamps on show were in particular some extremely rare commemorative ones, dating from the 1896 Games in Athens to those in Los Angeles in 1932.
