

P R E S S R E L E A S E

The International Olympic Committee Executive Board met on March 13th in the Château de Vidy in Lausanne.

Mr. Willi DAUME, President of the Organising Committee of the Games of the XXth Olympiad in Munich, was heard by the Executive Board on several points with regard to the next Olympic Games.

The two demonstration sports proposed are badminton in Munich and water-skiing in Kiel.

The Organising Committee will take all necessary action to avoid commercialisation of the Olympic Games, as well as politics.

On behalf of the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee, a letter will be sent to the Presidents of Radio Liberty and Radio Free Europe, radio stations transmitting programmes from Munich, to ask them to abide by the rules of the International Olympic Committee during the time of the Games and, by stopping any political propaganda in this respect, to observe the Olympic truce.

A similar request will be made to all other foreign broadcast companies in the Munich area.
