Lord Luke in Cologne

The second International Exhibition for the Construction of Sports Centres and Swimming Pools and the I.A.K.S. Congress were held in Cologne (Germany), from May 10th to 13th.

The following subject was selected: "Sport and Recreation Areas within Leisure Planning".

250 participants from 12 countries took part in the Exhibition.

The inaugural speech was made by Lord LUKE, member of the I.O.C. for Great Britain, President of the International Recreation Association and of the National Playing Fields Association.

Mr. Thomas KELLER, President of the Fédération Internationale des Sociétés d'Aviron, also spoke on behalf of the International Sports Federations.

The German Federal Republic Home Secretary, Mr. H.D. GENSCHER, closed the opening ceremony after having heard Mr. KUHN, President of the Westphalia Rhineland.
