THE ADMINISTRATION OF AN OLYMPIC GAMES by Sandy DUNCAN, Marcello GARRONI, Yukiaki IWATA.

This collection by three Olympic Games' "experts" who took part in the organisation of the Olympic Games in London, Rome and Tokyo, at the request of the International Olympic Committee, has been published for the cities that would like to undertake the organisation of the modern Olympic Games. It will also help the amateur to understand better all the difficulties and scope of such a quadrennial event.

This substantial collection, originally written in English, can be read as a novel.

THE NAZI OLYMPICS by Richard D. MANDELL. Publishers: *The Macmillan Company - 866 Third Avenue, New York, N.Y. 10022, USA. Price: \$7.95. (in English).*

In this brilliant work, Richard D. MANDELL retraces the history of the modern Olympic Games from their humble and modest beginning to their apogée in 1936, in Berlin. He describes the organisation which was, in essence, a superbly engineered piece of Nazi "Realpolitik". For the author, the millions of spectators thrilled at the massed parades, concourses of flapping banners and idolatrous solemnities. Over 5,000 athletes from 28 nations fought as political gladiators. In their hundreds, journalists, businessmen and foreign diplomats were pampered and overwhel-

med with attentions and cast aside their convictions and ability to judge and analyse, allowing themselves to be carried away by the prevailing tone. Nothing was spared to intoxicate the visitors, to lead them, like the Germans, into a state of false optimism. Even the persecutions of the Jews was temporarily halted ...

THE SPORTS POLICY UNDER THE THIRD REICH by Hajo BERNETT, professor at the Physical Education Institute of the Rhine University of Frederic Guillaume in Bonn. Publishers: *Karl HOFFMAN, Schondorf-Stuttgart for the German Commission of Physical Education Teachers. (Order No. 439). In German.*

Relations today between sport and the political powers are a real, problem and, in the East as well as in the West, have been the subject of many contemporary historical analyses. The use of physical education as a political tool was suspected for a long time, but it was only under the Third Reich that the dependence and servility of sport became more apparent. This remarkable study, with excellent documentation, attempts to analyse this politicized aspect of sport, so much requested and sought after by national-socialism.

KIPCHOGE OF KENYA by Francis NORONHA. Publishers: *Elimu - Commandes: Arena Publications, 325 Streatham High Road, London S.W. 16. Price: S.Fr. 12.00.*

This biography of one of the greatest present day athletes reads like a chapter from 100 years ago. It tells the story of a young African boy who has been brought up in Africa, far from 'civilized' life as we know it. The book tells of his hard life in the jungles of Kenya, his goat herding chores, his schooling and finally his contact with the outer world and how he conquers it to become one of the greatest runners in the world.

L'ANNEE HIPPIQUE (*The Equine Year*). 5 Place St. François, Lausanne (Switzerland). Price: S.Fr. 49.00. (In French).

Edition No. 28 of "The Equine Year" reviews the main events from twelve months of sport and equestrian activities. This work, richly illustrated with many photographs, will interest all amateurs of these sports. It may be interesting to note that the complete set of "L'Année Hippique" (28 volumes published from 1943 to 1970) make up a collection of about 700 articles and 13,000 photographic documents.

A brilliantly illustrated report by a French journalist, recalling the great moments of Mexico and its Games.

DIE OLYMPISCHEN SPIELE IN DER ANTIKE (*The Olympic Games in Ancient Times*) by Hermann BENGTSOHN Publishers: Artemis, Zurich and Stuttgart. Price: S.Fr. 9.80 (in German).

A very detailed study of the Olympic Games as they were in Ancient Times.

All you need to know on physical education and how to remain in good physical condition, from A to Z. This book is written for the benefit of physical education teachers by other physical education teachers. The foreword is by Philip Noel BAKER President of the International Council for Sport and Physical Education of UNESCO.

OLYMPIA 1896-1972. *Publishers; Panini - Modène, Italy.*

A marvellous children's album on the Olympic Games and Winter Games. It is divided into two parts: firstly, written information and secondly, individual squares where they can stick the vignettes of all the great names in each of the Games.
