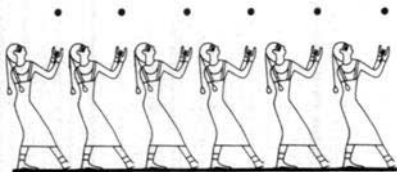


# In the International Federations



## FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE BASKETBALL AMATEUR

\* The 9th Congress of the *Fédération Internationale de Basketball Amateur* is to be held on the 23rd and 24th August next in Munich (Germany).

\* The 40th Anniversary of the founding of the *Fédération Internationale de Basketball Amateur* will be celebrated in Rome, Geneva, Madrid and Paris from the 17th to 23rd June 1972.

\* The Bulletin No. 50 for November 1971 contains all the results of the principal championships which took place in 1971.



## FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE CANOE

\* The *Fédération Internationale de Canoë* Congress will be held in Munich next August-September.

\* The World Canoe Sailing Championships will take place from the 5th to 13th August next at Oxelösund (Sweden).

\* The November bulletin of this federation includes all the results for the principal competitions during 1971.



FEDERATION EQUESTRE INTERNA-  
TIONALE

\* At the General Assembly of the *Fédération Equestre Internationale*, meeting in London last September, the Indian Equestrian Federation and the Equestrian Federation of the Arabic Republic of Egypt were unanimously voted affiliated members.

During this same meeting, Mr. E.A. SARASIN (Switzerland) was promoted to the position of first Vice President.

\* The calendar of the main events for 1972 is as follows:

- Junior European Jumping Championships: 27-30 July, Cork (Ireland);
- Junior European Three-Day Event Championships: 11-13 August, Eridge (Great Britain)
- World Driving Championships: 24-28 May, Munster (Germany).

\* The under-20s World Championships for four weapons will take place in Madrid (Spain) from the 1st to 5th April.

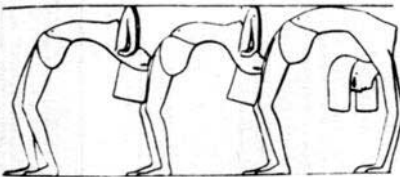


\* The Annual *Fédération Internationale d'Escrime* Congress will meet on the 18th, 19th and 20th May 1972 in Nice (France).

FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

\* Dr. Ottorino BARASSI, Vice President of the *Fédération Internationale de Football Association*, has just died in Rome at the age of 73, following a long illness. Dr. BARASSI joined FIFA in 1932 and has unceasingly worked for this sport and its development. We offer our most sincere condolences to his family and to the members of the FIFA.

\* Due to the vacancy caused by the death of Dr. BARASSI, Mr. Gustave WIEDERKEHR (Switzerland) becomes the new Vice President of FIFA.



FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE GYMNASTIQUE

\* Publications by the *Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique* during 1971:

- System of qualification;
- Supplement and modifications to the code of points for men and women;
- New Statutes;

- Rules for European Championships, including a new edition of the abbreviated terminology.

\* Three new national federations have been accepted as members of the *Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique*; they are: Ecuador, Lesotho and Liechtenstein.

\* The calendar for the *Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique* approved at the 50th General Assembly held last October in Madrid:

- European Championships (men) for 1973: France;
- European Championships (women) for 1973: Great Britain;
- World Modern Gymnastics Championships for 1973: Netherlands.

\* The 51st General Assembly of this federation will be held in Munich on 23rd August 1972.



#### FEDERATION HALTEROPHILE INTERNATIONALE

\* The *Fédération Haltérophile Internationale* Congress will sit on August 25th in Munich.

\* The World Weightlifting Championships will be held: in 1973, in Havana (Cuba) from 15th to 23rd September; in 1974, in Manilla (Philippines), and in 1975 in Moscow (U.S.S.R.).

The 31st European Championships will take place from 13th to 21st May 1972 in Constanza (Rumania).

\* Last October, the first *Fédération Haltérophile Internationale* coaching clinic was organised very successfully in Spa (Belgium). 12 coaches from 8 countries were present and the following subjects were covered:

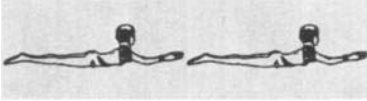
- mechanics and anatomy;
- mechanics of the pull;
- path of the bar in the Snatch;
- path of the bar in the Clean;
- technique of the Press, Snatch, Jerk;
- physical preparation of the lifter;
- a yearly programme of training;
- physiological basis of training;
- recuperation;
- refereeing problems for the coach;
- reducing body weight;
- psychological preparation of the lifter;
- observing and correcting faults.

\* The Annual Congress of the *Fédération Internationale de Luge de Course* will be held in Sapporo (Japan) on February 12.

\* The World Tobogganing Championships will take place in Oberhof (German Democratic Republic) in 1973.



FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE  
NATATION AMATEUR

\* The Board of the *Fédération Internationale de Natation Amateur*, meeting last November in Singapore, granted the organization of the first World Championships to Belgrade (Yugoslavia). They will be held on 17th, 18th and 19th August 1973.

\* The F.I.N.A. has just published the list of world records as at 31st December 1971.

\* The following decisions were made at the General Assembly of the European Shooting

## ... and the others

Federation, held in Suhl (GDR), concerning the modus of the shooting programme for the European Championships in which it is again optional to include the event of "running deer at 100 metres". During the year prior to World Championships, European Championships will be held for team events, and during the year prior to the Olympic Games, European Championships in individual events will take place. Furthermore, separate European Championships will be held in the Spring (February/March) for the air rifle and air pistol events.

\* For 1972, the European Championships in air rifle and air pistol (men, women and juniors) will be organised in Yugoslavia; the European Championships in rifle and pistol shooting for juniors in Sweden and the Great European Prize in trap and skeet shooting in Spain.

### FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DU SPORT UNIVERSITAIRE

\* During a meeting held in Paris last December, the Executive Board of the *Fédération Internationale du Sport Universitaire* unanimously voted Moscow (U.S.S.R.) as holders of the World University Games for 1973. In declaring this decision, Dr. Primo NEBIOLO, President, said "*We emphasise that the Executive Board of the Fédération Internationale du Sport Universitaire is very honoured at having received and accepted Moscow's candidature. Thus, within two years, we shall see these Winter Games in the United States at Lake Placid (25th February to 5th March, 1972) and the Summer University Games in the U.S.S.R. in Moscow. This is very important for the University sports movement.*"
