\* 75th anniversary of the Olympic Games. Issue : 16th December, 1971. Four values : 30h. - Greek athlete, temple of Olympia ; 40h. - athlete, Munich stadium ; 1.60K. - skier, emblem of Sapporo Games ; 2.60K. - discus thrower, emblem of the Czechoslovakian N.O.C. ## EIRE

\* To mark the 50th anniversary of the establishment of the "Olympic Council of Ireland", the Irish Department of Post and Telegraphs has started a competition open to all art students, over the age of 18, aimed at designing a stamp. We are publishing be-

low various particulars on this stamp :

- The stamp will be printed in photogravure in two values by the Revenue Commissioners.
- The size of the stamp will be 21 mm. by 37 mm.
- The design should be drawn to a size four times larger in each dimension than stamp size, i.e. 84 mm. by 148 mm.
- The Olympic five ring symbol is suggested as a motif but is not essential and students are free to present their own ideas.
- The name of the state "Eire", the Council's name "Comhairle Oluimpeach na h-Eireann 1922-1972" and the value of the stamp, e.g. 4, should be included.
- An award of £5 will be made for each of the six best designs.
- The designs submitted will become the exclusive property of the Minister for Post and Telegraphs, with all rights of reproduction and display.
- Should a design be accepted for use on the stamp a fee of £50 for the preparation of the design in final form will be paid.
