

The I.O.C. and the International Federations in Lausanne

The meeting, standard practice from now on, of the Executive Board with the International Federations will take place on 29th May at 9.30 a.m. in Lausanne (Palace Hotel, Richemont Room). The precedent was set in 1970 at Amsterdam. The representatives of the 21 Federations making up the Summer Olympic Games and the 5 Winter ones will be able to examine the future, with the IOC delegates, in the light of the recent events at the Sapporo Games.

We are publishing further on the agenda, formulated with the agreement of the IOC and the IFs.

Several Presidents of IOC Commissions are taking the

opportunity of this trip to Lausanne for calling their Commission members for a working session. They will, therefore, be discussing the eligibility of athletes, the future Olympic programme, the Games cultural programme, the International Olympic Academy and the coming Olympic Congress in 1973, under the presidencies of Messrs. WEIR, CSANADI, RECZEK, VIND and Lord KILLANIN, respectively.

Then, the Executive Board, presided over by Mr. Avery BRUNDAGE, has four working days so as to prepare for the 73rd IOC Session, which will begin on 19th August with the Solemn Opening in the Munich Theatre, attended by the President of the German Federal Republic, Mr. HEINEMANN.
