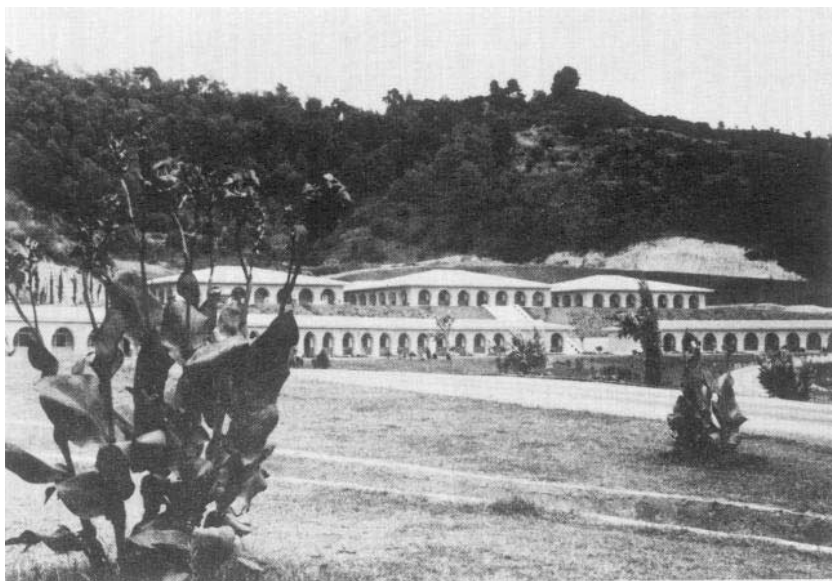


XIIth session of the International Olympic Academy



The XIIth Session of the International Olympic Academy, under the presidency of Mr. Epaminondas PETRALIAS, will be held in Olympia (Greece) from 12th to 30th July, 1972.
